This technology can support teams at research-oriented universities, such as the University of Alberta and the University of Calgary, to advance their efforts to develop life-altering medications for patients.

By combining richly structured biomedical data with advanced software and Al tools, DrugBank helps users navigate complex biological and clinical information—accelerating everything from target identification and trial landscaping to safety monitoring and market analysis.

Lisa Downey, CEO of DrugBank, says Alberta provides the ideal environment for companies like DrugBank.

"The Edmonton region has become a gateway for drug research and development. It is home to world-class research institutes, including Alberta Machine Intelligence Institute (Amii) and the University of Alberta, which provides a deep talent pool."

This tool is helping Alberta scientists and universities discover and repurpose medicines faster, ultimately lowering R&D costs and accelerating access to new therapies that improve patient outcomes.

## **Funding Innovation and Innovators**

Provincial efforts to attract Venture Capital firms with strategically aligned funds, through Alberta Enterprise Corporation (AEC), have helped propel the DrugBank to where it is today.
