





Fluid Biomed is a medical device company founded by two Alberta neurosurgeons: Dr. Alim Mitha and Dr. John Wong. They wanted to create safer, more effective tools for treating brain aneurysms – a dangerous condition where a blood vessel weakens and can burst, causing a stroke or even death.

Their minimally invasive solution is **benefiting communities** by making complex brain treatments safer, simpler, and more widely accessible.

"Our team developed the world's first bioabsorbable brain stent - a tiny device that once implanted by a specialist, seals off the brain aneurysm, supports healing inside the blood vessel, and then safely dissolves," Dr. Mitha explains.
